It is therefore important that you complete SECTION C as fully as possible, clearly setting out an argument as to why you should receive a scholarship AND provide the necessary documentary evidence supporting your application. Add more pages if required.

Some examples of Documentary Evidence that can be provided. Not all need be provided.

For Merit Students:

- Exceptionally high standard report from year 12
- Supporting letter from Principal
- Results for any additional study completed outside of school
- Supporting letter from employer [if employed] together with work record
- Evidence of Charitable Work / Volunteer Work

For Financial Hardship Students:

- Proof of hardship from authorities
- Evidence of hospitalization or serious illness of one of the parents
- Supporting letter from Principal on the basis of hardship
